The film “ Król Biebrzy” („The King of Biabrze River”) was awarded with the II place at the Ekoforum Film Festival

The reportage “... taki poprzeczny człowiek” („...such a square man” received the second award at I Festival of Television Reportage, Włocławek 2000 , and at IV Review of Journalist Work TVP S.A., Gdańsk 2000 and was nominated for the GRAND PRESS 2000 Award.

The documentary “ Maszer” (“Musher”) , produces for Channel 1 Polish television, was awarded with Grand Prix at the Polish Journalist Competition „Open Eyes” 2002 for the best television documentary and was nominated for the GRAND PRESS 2002 Award.

The documentary „ Proroczy żywot Eliasza” was awarded with Special Prize at VIII Review of Journalist Work TVP S.A., 2004.

The film „Rzeka” („River”) received an Honorary Award at the Awards of the Journalist Association, 2004.
